Woodley Hammers FC, holders of the F.A. Charter Standard Development Club Status, hosted an exciting and friendly football tournament at the Bulmershe School, Woodley on the weekend of 1st June and 2nd June. The tournament was a great success and was blessed with much better weather than last year.

Hammers accepted entries from 243 teams from Under 7s through to adults including four Girls' sections. Teams travelled from 13 Counties across the South East to participate in this prestigious Tournament. This was an impressive number of teams at Bulmershe School considering the number of local Tournaments that have had to have been cancelled due to low entry levels. Those teams that participated commented on how well the Tournament was run and how much they enjoyed it.

Woodley Hammers Chairman, Bill Rodda said "We were delighted to host our tournament at Bulmershe School and to reinforce our commitment to develop football in the community in partnership with Bulmershe School. This weekend we were fortunate to have some excellent weather which added to everyone's enjoyment. In line with our development strategy we continued to host Girls' sections offering four in all. Our motto 'Gaudium Joci Causa' translates as 'Enjoyment Through Sport' and sums up this tournament weekend. I would particularly like to thank the teams that entered for their excellent attitude and behaviour and hope they had a fantastic day. Our annual tournament is very important to the club in demonstrating that we are welcoming club which enhances our recruitment of new players. It also has a significant financial impact in that, with ever growing costs to provide football and the current economic climate, it helps to keep down our Registration and Match Fees during the course of the season". He went on to say "Our events co-ordinator, Tracey Marshall and her team, did an excellent job and made it an enjoyable weekend for all who attended. I would like to thank all of the Club Members who made the weekend run smoothly and to Bulmershe School for their continued support."

Tracey Marshall events co-ordinator added "I was extremely grateful to all the sponsors and helpers that made the weekend such a success. I would particularly like to thank Travis Perkins for all their logistical support. With the high number of teams it presented a challenge regarding car parking which was superbly covered by the team. I would particularly like to thank the team that organised the first aid cover over the weekend in such a professional way and I hope that all those that needed attention recover quickly."

Marshall added "The event went to schedule over the weekend which was quite an achievement considering we had 243 teams participating across 13 pitches. We were very impressed with the way the referees kept the matches flowing and are grateful to Steve McMahon and Steve Smith, the referees' co-ordinators, for their organising skills. We have received some great feedback from participating teams about the quality and friendliness of the referees."

Hammers had teams competing from a wide geographical area including the local Reading area and the surrounding counties of Buckinghamshire, Dorset, Hampshire, Hertfordshire, Kent, London, Middlesex, Oxfordshire, Somerset, Surrey, West Sussex and Wiltshire.

Club Chairman, Rodda added "In particular we are grateful to the governors, Headteacher Emma Reynolds and staff of Bulmershe School who kindly allowed the tournament to take place in their grounds. We have been developing a relationship with Bulmershe School since the mid 1990s to help improve the sports facilities at the school and working as a Community Partner with the school. A significant proportion of the revenues from previous Tournaments has been used by the school to assist with this aim. We were delighted to have an agreement with the school that has given us exclusive use of their quality football pitch out of school hours during the course of this season. Part of our development plan is to continue to work with the school for our mutual benefit and that of the local community."

Bulmershe School Headteacher, Emma Reynolds said "We were delighted to host another really successful Woodley Hammer's Football Annual Small Sided Side football tournament over the weekend. Over 1,900 participants attended and 800 games of football were played. We were especially thrilled with the girls' turnout - 24 female teams played. Thank you to everyone who supported this excellent event and we look forward to a continuing strong partnership with Woodley Hammers."

With a strong foundation in training and fun games from the Under 7s upwards the Club has had a successful season in 2012-2013. In the season just ended the Under 11 Blue squad won the Berkshire Youth Development Division 3 and were runners-up in the Plate Competition, the Under 14 Blue squad were runners-up in the East Berkshire Youth Football League Division 4 and the Saturday Seniors were winners in the Reading and District Saturday League Division 2.
